

Spring Brook Township Recycling Information

Spring Brook Township currently has an agreement with Covington Township to allow our residents to drop off recyclables at the Covington Township Recycling Center on the 1st and 3rd Saturday of each month between the hours of 9:00 AM and 11:00 AM. The Covington Township Recycling Center is located off of Route 435 in Daleville behind Occhipinti Dance Company. **Please See Additional Information Below!**

Only the following items are accepted:

*Glass – Bottles and Jars Only – Tops must be thrown away. Rinse Out Bottles and Jars!
NO windows, ceramics, drinking glasses, etc.

*Cans – Aluminum and Steel (Tin) – Beverage and Food Containers – Rinse Out Containers!

*Plastic – Bottles and Jars with Tops – Milk, juice, energy drinks, water, detergents, soda, etc. – Rinse Out Bottles and Jars! **NO toys, bags, cups, plant pots, Styrofoam, etc.**

*Newspapers, Magazines, Catalogs , Brown Bags and Phonebooks – Please place in a brown paper bag or bundle and tie with string.

*Office Paper – Computer Paper, Mail (With your personal information removed), Envelopes and Shredded Paper – Please place in a clear plastic bag.

*Corrugated Cardboard Boxes

NO Electronics, Appliances or Styrofoam will be accepted!
